



COVID Catch Up Premium

Schools have been allocated this funding for specific activities to support their pupils to catch up for lost teaching over the previous months, in line with guidance on curriculum expectations for the next academic year. It can also be used to support wellbeing and mental health.

Schools have flexibility to spend their funding in the best way for their cohort and circumstances.

Mainstream schools are to receive £80 per pupil.

Westleigh St Paul's have been allocated £15,760 with the first instalment of £3,940 was paid in October 2020.

Second instalment of £5540 was paid in February 2021.

The final allocation is due in the summer term 2021.

The school has already spent above and beyond this amount purchasing:

Software and equipment to support online and remote learning.

Resources to be used in school tailored to need.
